## **DCE HOLDS COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AT ABOABOGYA**

He went on to say that the Community center will go a long way to help the Community in so many ways. He then urged the DCE to continue with his good work by supporting the Aboabogya Community with developmental project.

The DCE on his part appealed to the chiefs and the people to put aside all things and support the Government on the development of their various communities. He urged the people of Aboabogya to practice a good maintenance culture.

During an open forum, the people raised concerns and asked questions regarding education, electricity, health, sanitation etc.

They requested for the fixing of some street lights in the community since all the street lights are not working. They also requested for mechanized bore hole and a decent toilet facility.

In response to some of these questions Hon Adu Poku explained that, the Assembly has the will to provide developmental project to all the communities in the district but the assembly do not have the financial strength so, they will tackle the developmental project that is not beyond them.

He pointed out that, people should play a role in the development process that is the community should initiate a project that will be of benefit to the community and the assembly is ever ready to support them.

Hon. Adu Poku took the opportunity to advise the youth to start their own business since the MP is ready to support the youth who are interested in fish farming.
