DCE HOLDS COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AT EBOM - BOMFA

The maiden edition of a working tour by the Afigya Kwabre South District Assembly dubbed 'Community Engagement' saw the District Chief Executive Hon. Christian Adu Poku and his entourage comprising some departmental heads visited the people of Ebom - Bomfa, in the District on the 25th January 2022.

Hon. Christian Adu Poku made it known that the engagement was part of the assembly's initiative to bring governance to the grass root level to get the people involved in governance and development process.

He gave brief accounts on some of the developmental project his government has achieved during his tenure as DCE, construction of road from Aduman junction to Ebom-Bomfa, 20 seater WC at Aduman SHS etc.

Hon. Christian Adu Poku, disclosed the development plan for the district that is. the construction of the district hospital at Atrama agenda 111, construction of midwifery training school at Brofoyedru.

He used the occasion to appeal to the chiefs and the people to put aside all things and concentrate on the development of their various community. He formally commissioned a 6 seater water closet which was built by the people of Swedru and supported by the Member of Parliament for Afigya Kwabre South, Hon. Owuraku Aidoo Williams.

Chief of Ebom - Bomfa thanked the DCE and his entourage for their initiative. He disclosed to the DCE that he is supporting the assembly with 4000 blocks to build the proposed police station to be constructed in Adwumakasekese.

HE indicated that, the community needed extension of lights to some parts of the community since crime could flourish in areas without light.

During an open forum, the people raised concerns and asked questions regarding education, electricity, health, sanitation etc.

Nana Boateng, Kontihene of Ebom, requested for some development for their community which include, extension of electricity, toilet facilit ,gutters alongside the road leading to Ebom etc.

They requested for the fixing of some broking window and doors of the Ebom community classroom block and borehole for the school. In all, the community the DCE and his team visited requested for toilet facility and electricity extension and security was a major concern to the people.

In response to some of these questions Hon Adu Poku explained that, the assembly has the will to provide developmental project to all the communities in the district but the assembly do not have the financial strength so, they will tackle the developmental project that is not beyond them.

On the issue of sanitation, he indicated that it would not be advisable for people to continue dumping refuse on the ground because dumping on the ground is a thing of the past.

He assured the people of Ebom of his support in getting a dumping site for the community.

He pointed out that, people should play a role in the development process that is the community should initiate a project that will be of benefit to the community and the assembly is ever ready to support them.

Hon. Adu Poku took the opportunity to advise the youth to start their own business since the MP is ready to support the youth who are interested in fish farming.

Dignitaries present to grace the occasion were Mr. Andrews Mensah (DCD), Heads of Department, Nana Boateng Kontihene of Ebom, and the general public.
