DCE INTERACTS WITH COMMUNITY MEMBERS, COMMISSION'S HEALTH CENTRE

The District Chief Executive for Afigya Kwabre South, Hon. Christian Adu-Poku accompanied by some key staff and Assembly members embarked on community visitation on 8th February 2022. The purpose of the visit was to interact with the Chiefs and people within the district and to drum home government policies particularly, the trending issue of E-levy to them.

The communities visited were Ankaase and Aboabogya where the Honourable informed them the commitment of the Assembly to work assiduously to bring development into the District.

At Ankaase, the Odikro, Nana Kwadwo Akwaboah with with his elders and subjects, outlined their challenges relating to sanitation and roads, among others. They urged the government to give broader details on E-levy for the people to know its benefits.

After carefully listening to their concerns, Hon Adu-Poku assured them of addressing the prioritized ones but admonished them to also embark on self-help projects instead of waiting for the government to shoulder all their needs.

In his address at Aboabogya, the Chief Executive commended the traditional leaders and the people for smoking the pipe of peace and called on the citizenry to rally behind the Chief and the Queen for accelerated development which has for long eluded the community. According to him, due to prolong dispute, many projects meant for the community were diverted to other communities.

At the durbar grounds, the "Revised Aboabogya Local Plan" meant to strategize the proper lay-out development of the town was exhibited.

For his part, the Aboabogyahene Nana Wiafe Akenten Amoah II, appreciated the efforts of the DCE for his contribution towards the peace process. He expressed delight over the prevalent peace and called for love and united front for the community's development.

Hon Adu-Poku and his team together with the Chief and his elders, commissioned the renovated Health Centre in the town to cater for the health care of the people.
